

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5618

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium**
3 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following**

17 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
18 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
19 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
20 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State**
21 **Police, for the following purposes:**

- 22 (1) **Patrol services, criminal**
- 23 **investigations and**
- 24 **gaming enforcement \$ 25,894,313**
- 25 (2) **Fish and wildlife enforcement... \$ 15,818,577**
- 26 (3) **Forensic services and**
- 27 **State Medical Examiner..... \$ 1,898,735**
- 28 (4) **Administrative services and**
- 29 **information management..... \$ 10,985,689**
- 30 (5) **Office of Emergency Management,**
- 31 **State Fire Marshal and**

34 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment

1 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 5 of this 2005 Act col-
2 lected or received by the Department of State Police for the following purposes:

14 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, and notwithstanding
15 ORS 541.377 (7), the amount of \$6,356,880 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,
16 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Police for
17 fish and wildlife enforcement activities from moneys or other revenues allocated to the
18 Parks and Natural Resources Fund and from lottery funds made available to the Parks and
19 Natural Resources Fund under section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

20 **“SECTION 5.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department
21 of State Police for payments to cities and counties for federal emergency management as-
22 sistance and for payments for the emergency management performance grant from funds
23 from the United States Department of Homeland Security are not limited.

24 **“SECTION 6.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
26 July 1, 2005.”.
