SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to _____ for biennial expenses.]
[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures by _____ from federal funds.]
Authorizes certain state agencies to continue operating on or after July 1, 2005, as authorized for last quarter of 2003-2005 biennium.
Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to reconcile funds expended by state agencies with 2005-2007 budgets.
Sunsets July 31, 2005.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. As used in sections 1 to 4 of this 2005 Act, "state agency" means every state**
5 **officer, board, commission, department, institution, branch or agency of the state govern-**
6 **ment, the costs of which are paid wholly or in part from funds held in the State Treasury.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 291.232 to 291.260, and subject to any rule that may**
8 **be adopted by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, any obligations incurred**
9 **by a state agency on or after July 1, 2005, that do not exceed the level of expenditures au-**
10 **thorized under ORS 291.232 to 291.260 or otherwise authorized for the last quarter of the**
11 **2003-2005 biennium are hereby authorized, and necessary funds are appropriated therefor,**
12 **unless the Oregon Department of Administrative Services determines that the state agency's**
13 **expenditure level should be modified, based on pending legislation.**

14 **(2) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services by rule shall specify the means**
15 **whereby funds expended pursuant to subsection (1) of this section are reconciled and charged**
16 **to the state agency's 2005-2007 legislatively approved budget during the 2005-2007 biennium.**

17 **(3) All payments for debt service, certificates of participation and other financing agree-**
18 **ments are hereby authorized during the period commencing July 1, 2005.**

19 **SECTION 3. Sections 1 to 4 of this 2005 Act apply to a state agency for which no**
20 **legislatively approved budget has been enacted on or before July 1, 2005.**

21 **SECTION 4. If there is no 2005-2007 legislatively approved budget upon final adjournment**
22 **of the regular session of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly against which any expendi-**
23 **ture authorized by section 2 (1) of this 2005 Act can be applied, the expenditure shall be**

1 considered to have been made from funds appropriated to the Oregon Department of Ad-
2 ministrative Services. For the purpose of paying the incurred expenses of state agencies,
3 there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services any cash or
4 other funds remaining in the accounts of the state agency for which no budget has been
5 approved and for which no expenditure authority exists when the Legislative Assembly ad-
6 journs sine die. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services may apply for re-
7 imbursement from the Emergency Board of any expenditure made under this section during
8 the 2005-2007 biennium.

9 **SECTION 5.** Sections 1 to 4 of this 2005 Act are repealed on July 31, 2005.

10 **SECTION 6.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
12 July 1, 2005.
