

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5629

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
3 priated to the Director of Veterans’ Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of
4 the General Fund, the amount of \$2,600,000, which may be expended for purposes described
5 in section 2, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).

6 “**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
7 priated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of
8 the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, which may be expended for tuition waivers granted
9 pursuant to ORS 399.275 and 399.280, as amended by sections 1 and 2, chapter 200, Oregon
10 Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 486).

11 “**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
12 priated to the Oregon Military Emergency Financial Assistance Fund created in section 10,
13 chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100), for the biennium beginning
14 July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, which may be expended by the
15 Oregon Military Department for the purposes described in section 9, chapter _____,
16 Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).

17 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
18 \$500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
19 payment of expenses by the Oregon Military Department from fees, moneys or other reven-
20 ues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected
21 or received for the Oregon Military Emergency Financial Assistance Fund established by
22 section 10, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).

23 “**SECTION 5.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
24 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
25 July 1, 2005.”
