**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [\_\_\_\_\_] **Director of Veterans' Affairs, Oregon Military Department and Oregon Military Emergency Financial Assistance Fund** for **certain** biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [\_\_\_\_\_] **Oregon Military Department.**

*[Limits biennial expenditures by \_\_\_\_\_ from federal funds.]*

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring  
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
6 **ated to the Director of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
7 **General Fund, the amount of \$2,600,000, which may be expended for purposes described in**  
8 **section 2, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).**

9 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
10 **ated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
11 **General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, which may be expended for tuition waivers granted**  
12 **pursuant to ORS 399.275 and 399.280, as amended by sections 1 and 2, chapter 200, Oregon**  
13 **Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 486).**

14 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
15 **ated to the Oregon Military Emergency Financial Assistance Fund created in section 10,**  
16 **chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100), for the biennium beginning**  
17 **July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, which may be expended by the**  
18 **Oregon Military Department for the purposes described in section 9, chapter \_\_\_\_\_,**  
19 **Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).**

20 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$500,000**  
21 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of**  
22 **expenses by the Oregon Military Department from fees, moneys or other revenues, including**  
23 **Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received**  
24 **for the Oregon Military Emergency Financial Assistance Fund established by section 10,**  
25 **chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1100).**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1        **SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
2        **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
3        **July 1, 2005.**

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
