

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5630

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

July 18

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
4 **riated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
5 **General Fund, the amount of \$1,471,866, for payment of expenses related to those provisions**  
6 **of chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled Senate Bill 907), that create crimes or**  
7 **change sentences for existing crimes.**

8 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
9 **riated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
10 **General Fund, the amount of \$900,000, which may be expended for transitional housing and**  
11 **substance abuse treatment for offenders participating in an alternative incarceration pro-**  
12 **gram who are granted transitional leave under ORS 421.510.**

13 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
14 **riated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
15 **General Fund, the amount of \$550,087, which may be expended for assisting district attorneys**  
16 **and law enforcement agencies in the investigation and prosecution of cases related to**  
17 **methamphetamine.**

18 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
19 **riated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005,**  
20 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$450,000, for payment of expenses related to in-**  
21 **creased prosecution of, and increased prosecution resources for, cases related to metham-**  
22 **phetamine.**

23 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
24 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
25 **July 1, 2005.”.**
