

**HOUSE MINORITY REPORT  
AMENDMENTS TO  
B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 571  
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

June 12

Speaker Merkley:

A minority of your Committee on Human Services and Women's Wellness, to whom was referred B-engrossed Senate Bill 571, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that it do pass with the following amendments:

1       On page 3 of the printed B-engrossed bill, after line 36, insert:

2       “(f) Smoking is permitted in rooms or halls being used by a charitable, fraternal or religious  
3 organization to conduct bingo games under a license issued pursuant to ORS 464.270.”.

4       On page 6, after line 10, insert:

5       “**SECTION 12a. If Senate Bill 84 becomes law, section 12 of this 2007 Act (amending ORS  
6 441.030) is repealed.**”.

7       On page 8, after line 3, insert:

8       “**SECTION 14.** ORS 433.850, as amended by section 4 of this 2007 Act, is amended to read:

9       “433.850. (1) An employer shall provide a place of employment that is free of tobacco smoke for  
10 all employees.

11       “(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section:

12       “(a) The owner or person in charge of a hotel or motel may designate up to 25 percent of the  
13 sleeping rooms of the hotel or motel as rooms in which smoking is permitted.

14       “(b) Smoking of noncommercial tobacco products for ceremonial purposes is permitted in spaces  
15 designated for traditional ceremonies in accordance with the American Indian Religious Freedom  
16 Act, 42 U.S.C. 1996.

17       “(c) Smoking is permitted in a smoke shop.

18       “(d) Smoking is permitted in a cigar bar that generated on-site retail sales of cigars of at least  
19 \$5,000 for the calendar year ending December 31, 2006.

20       “(e) Smoking is permitted in a race course as defined in ORS 462.010 unless prohibited by the  
21 licensed race meet operator.

22       “*[(f) Smoking is permitted in rooms or halls being used by a charitable, fraternal or religious or-  
23 ganization to conduct bingo games under a license issued pursuant to ORS 464.270.]*

24       “(3) An employer, except in those places described in subsection (2) of this section, shall post  
25 signs that provide notice of the provisions of ORS 433.835 to 433.875.

26       “**SECTION 15. The amendments to ORS 433.850 by section 14 of this 2007 Act become  
27 operative on January 2, 2010.**”.

28       In line 4, delete “14” and insert “16”.

29       In line 5, delete “15” and insert “17”.
