WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Enables the Oregon State Police, State Fire Marshal to maintain fee increases that have been approved by the Department of Administrative Services.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Removes fees not subject to ratification requirement and adds fees inadvertently left off the original bill.

BACKGROUND: Statute requires that agencies granted authority to establish new fees or fee increases during the interim receive written approval from the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for agencies in the executive branch. This is sometimes referred to as the SB 333 process.
