2011 Selected list of Co-Sponsored Bills**

Bills Passed	
Bill #	Description
HB 2019	Provides that Adjutant General may not place or retain person in unit designated for active federal service outside state if person is sibling of person killed while serving on active duty with Armed Forces of United States.
HB 2321	Authorizes public body to send notice by electronic mail if person enters into agreement with public body to receive notice by electronic mail and certain other conditions are met.
HB 2919	Authorizes Oregon Business Development Department to make grants to small businesses from Building Opportunities for Oregon Small Business Today Account if business hires veteran as new full-time employee.
HB 3311	Requires Oregon Health Authority to explore ways to use doulas to improve birth outcomes for women who face disproportionately greater risk of poor birth outcomes
HB 3325	Modifies application of provision under which Department of Environmental Quality may enter into agreement with prospective purchaser of land under which purchaser is released from potential liability for certain releases, threatened releases or spills of hazardous substances or oil.
HB 3362	Allows sponsor and public charter school to enter into cooperative agreement with other school districts for purpose of forming partnership to provide educational services.
HB 3375	Modifies provisions for development and maintenance of telephone service that provides referral information regarding services after emergency and health and human services.
HB 3416	Establishes World War II Memorial Task Force to solicit private funding and arrange for development, design and construction of memorial to honor Oregon's World War II veterans.
HB 3500	Directs Oregon Military Department to report to legislative committee on existing military cultural barriers that discourage service members from identifying barriers to reintegration into civilian life.
HB 3611	Requires person who submits death certificate after decedent's death was caused by suicide to make reasonable efforts to ascertain and to notify Center for Health Statistics whether decedent was veteran ...
SB 224	Modifies provisions relating to regulation of physician assistants.
SB 241	Requires state agencies to ask if customer or client is veteran and provide information from Dept. of Veterans' Affairs and reintegration team within Oregon Military Department to veterans.
SB 443	Extends sunset on provision allowing federal forest reserve moneys in Douglas County road fund and Lane County road fund to be used for law enforcement purposes.
SB 444	Expands exemption of homemade beer, wine and fermented fruit juice from Liquor Control Act.
SB 447	Provides that Department of Transportation may remove personal property deposited, left or displayed under state highway bridge along river within urban growth boundary after posting written notice ...
SB 494	Eliminates sunset on provisions related to business development loans and entrepreneurial development loans.
HCR 23	In memoriam: Ben Westlund, 1949-2010.
HJM 25	Urges Congress to reauthorize and extend Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000.
HJM 28	Urges United States Department of Energy to remove Hanford Nuclear Reservation from list of candidate sites for national permanent storage of radioactive waste.
SCR 13	Honors Eugene Water & Electric Board for 100 years of utility service.
Bills Stalled	
HB 2242	Establishes Task Force on County Jail Populations to study methods for managing county jail bed demand.
HB 2260	Requires disclosure of shipping and handling charges in sale or advertisement of consumer goods.

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HB 2271	Prohibits health care facilities from charging or attempting to collect from patient or third party payer for cost of serious reportable event for which Medicare denies payment.
HB 2313	Instructs Bureau of Labor and Industries to study development of definition of "independent contractor" by rule
HB 2466	Prohibits sending of unsolicited facsimiles [i.e. junk mail to your fax machine]
HB 2824	Creates crime of trafficking in bicycles with a destroyed or altered serial number.
HB 2851	Expands breaches of security for which notification is required under Oregon Consumer Identity Theft Protection Act to include written data that contains personal information.
HB 2907	Creates Task Force on Microlending and directs task force to study need and anticipated demand for microlending programs ...
HB 2954	Creates Task Force on Procuring Through Small and Local Businesses.
HB 2957 HB 3639	Prohibits owner of foreclosed residential real property from neglecting real property during periods of vacancy.
HB 3473	Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to enter into contracts for purpose of making educational information systems available to school districts.
HB 3564	Establishes Governor's Office of Information Technology and specifies powers, responsibilities and duties of office.
HB 3565	Directs Dept. of Administrative Services to conduct assessment of state's information technology....
HB 3567	Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to conduct assessment of state's desktop computers and mobile workstations.
HB 3568	Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to establish project management process and certain standards for managing information technology projects for state government.
HB 3642	Appropriates moneys from Oregon Rainy Day Fund to Department of Human Services, Oregon Youth Authority and Department of State Police for specified purposes.
HB 3653	Expands definition of "farm use" to include facilities for training dogs in canine skills on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
HB 3683	Establishes University of Oregon as independent public university, governed by Board of Directors.
HB 3689	Creates unlawful practice of manufacturing, distributing, selling or offering for sale child's beverage container or reusable bottle made or lined with bisphenol A or replacement material that is carcinogenic or is reproductive toxicant.
HJM 11	Urges Congress to allow apprenticeship training and on-the-job training as benefit in Post 9/11 GI Bill.
HJR 40	Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require that initiative petition proposing law or constitutional amendment with fiscal impact also provide new tax or fee or increase in rate of existing tax or fee to cover immediate and future costs of law or amendment.
SB 439	Clarifies that statutes regulating physical therapy apply to person who uses word or title to induce belief that person is practicing physical therapy.
SB 559	Establishes University of Oregon as independent public university, governed by Board of Directors.
SB 781	Requires qualifying electricity for which bundled renewable energy certificate is issued ... to be produced by facility ... to comply with renewable portfolio standard.
SJR 20	Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow state to loan credit and incur specified amount of indebtedness to provide moneys to partially fund endowments at public universities.
