**REPRESENTATIVE BERGER FILES FOR RE-ELECTION**

SALEM – State Representative Vicki Berger (R-Salem) filed today for re-election to the House of Representatives for House District 20. The district includes West Salem, portions of South Salem, Monmouth and Independence.

“I feel very good about my legislative service,” said Rep. Berger. “It was a long and difficult session but good things were accomplished for Oregon such as PERS reform and the transportation package.”

As a freshman during the 2003 legislative session, Rep. Berger served as Vice-Chair of the Trade and Economic Development Committee and served on the Revenue Committee. During the interim, Rep. Berger will be working on updating our land use system as Vice Chair of the Interim House Committee on Land Use Review and has also been appointed to the Joint Legislative Audit Committee.

“The tax reform effort started during the session needs to be complete in the larger arena of public input. Our land use system needs revision in order to be responsive to the changing global business market while retaining the quality of life which is uniquely Oregon. We must keep healthcare affordable and public education accessible. These are the issues I will be focusing on during the interim and the next legislative session,” said Rep. Berger.
