PUBLIC INVITED TO LEGISLATIVE WORKSHOP

SALEM—Oregonians interested in tips on how best to work with the State Legislature are invited to a free workshop next week.

"How to Participate in the Legislative Process," will be offered Monday, Jan. 29, from 6 to 8 p.m. in Hearing Room E of the State Capitol at 900 Court St., N.E. in Salem. This is the same workshop previously scheduled for Jan. 16, but cancelled due to snow.

Senate President Peter Courtney (D-Salem/Gervais/Woodburn), Senator Frank Morse (R-Albany), Representative Diane Rosenbaum (D-Portland) and others will participate in a panel discussion describing effective ways to participate in the legislative process.
