OREGON HOUSE CELEBRATES CITY OF SUTHERLIN CENTENNIAL

SALEM—The Oregon House of Representatives Tuesday 100th birthday, which was on May 3. HCR35, sponsored by House Co-Speaker Bruce Hanna (R-Roseburg), passed with a vote of 58-0.

Co-Speaker Hanna made the following remarks while carrying the bill on the House floor during Tuesday's session:

“Colleagues, HCR 35 recognizes the city of Sutherlin on its centennial, which occurred last week on May 3.

Founded in 1911, Sutherlin is a beautiful city in Douglas County. It was the beauty of the area that drew Fendel Sutherlin, the city's founder, to settle in the area in 1845. Traveling between California and Oregon, he saw this spot and decided it was the perfect place to settle and serve as a home for his family.

I appreciate the people of Sutherlin, the pride they have in their community, the good work they do for one another, and the efforts underway to continue growing their city and their economy.

Sutherlin is a hospitable place and if you have not yet been there, I encourage you to join me this summer for one of their many festivals, community events or to taste some of the fabulous wine grown in and around the city.
