The State Capitol is celebrating Oregon's statehood on Monday, February 14th, with the following events:

- Beginning at noon, the Oregon State Legislature and Oregon Arts Commission will celebrate the reinstallation of the Capitol Art Collection, honoring over 150 Oregon artists. A reception will be held and the newest acquisition, funded through the Ford Family Foundation's Art Acquisition Program, will be unveiled at 12:30 pm in the Senate Lobby.
- At 1:00 pm, the Governor and legislative dignitaries will gather in the Galleria for a birthday cake cutting celebration. The Oregon Wheat Growers League is donating the cake.
- Starting at 3:30 pm in the Galleria, the Oregon Historical Society, in partnership with the Oregon State Capitol Foundation, will host a reception to showcase the new exhibit located on the first floor titled "Oregon's Landmark Legislation".
- The 121-step tour up to the Gold Pioneer will be offered every hour (weather permitting)
- Shoppers will receive 14% off most items in the Capitol Gift Shop
- The Oregon State Legislature will be in session, with committee hearings starting at 8:00 am.
