REP. SMITH EARNS HIGH SCORE FROM OREGON ANTI-CRIME ALLIANCE

(Salem) [Representative Greg Smith \(R-Heppner\)](#) earned a [94% score on the Oregon Anti-Crime Alliance \(OAA\) 2009 voting scorecard](#). According to the group, the scorecard measures votes on bills that have the greatest impact on their mission to make Oregon “one of the top five seats in the nation for low-crime rates.”

“[The Oregon Anti-Crime Alliance](#) scorecard demonstrates my strong commitment to keeping our communities safe,” Rep. Smith said. “I’m proud to support bills that advance Oregon’s reputation as a state that’s determined to be tough on crime. As a member of the Ways and Means Committee, I have also worked to give our State Police, the Department of Corrections and the Oregon Youth Authority the resources they need to investigate crimes and hold criminals accountable.”

The OAA scorecard tracked legislators’ votes on many of the session’s most important public safety bills. Rep. Smith joined OAA in voting to crack down on sexual predators, repeat drunk drivers and those who assault or murder pregnant women. He also supported legislation to provide speedy trial rights to crime victims.

“Oregonians deserve an effective criminal justice system,” Rep. Smith said. “I will continue to support legislation that helps our law enforcement officers and district attorneys. In addition, I am dedicated to helping to deliver justice for crime victims.”
