## **Senate Republican Leader statement on revenue forecast**

**Salem, OR** – Senate Republican Leader Ted Ferrioli (R-John Day) issued the following statement following Thursday’s state revenue forecast:

“Today’s revenue forecast demonstrates that Oregon families continue to be deeply concerned about paying their bills and finding opportunity for long term employment, even as their economic distress is reflected in consistently weak revenue returns.

“To date, the legislature has failed to demonstrate commitment to creating lasting, family wage jobs in Oregon through major policy changes. Until the legislature cuts spending and reduces administrative and bureaucratic barriers to economic growth, we will continue to see anemic revenue forecasts. Two hundred fifty thousand Oregonians are awaiting the changes that will create a thriving, robust economy that is attractive and welcoming to entrepreneurs, job creating investment, and growth in existing businesses.”
